Documents integumentary system •include skin, its accessory structures including hair, nails, and glands, as well as blood vessels, muscles and nerves. -all 4 of basic tissue types are represented: Epithelium in hair, nails, epidermis of skin; dermis contains C.T.; muscle is found attached to the hair follicles, and in substance of arteries and veins; nerves provide abundance of sensation.
